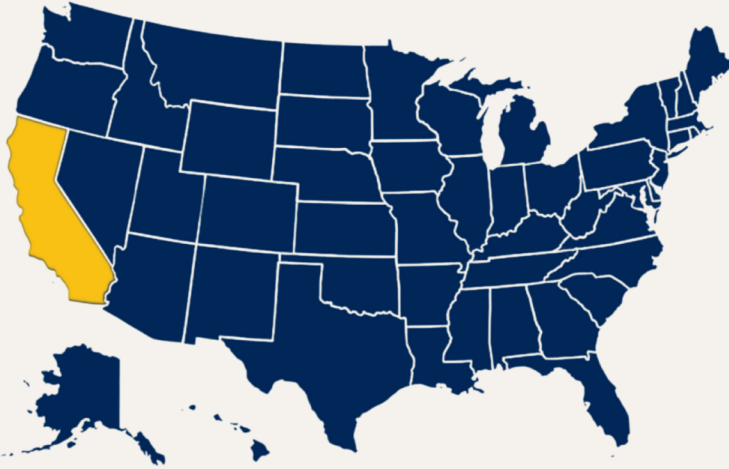




# CALIFORNIA'S LACK OF ACTION

## SHRINKING WORKFORCE:

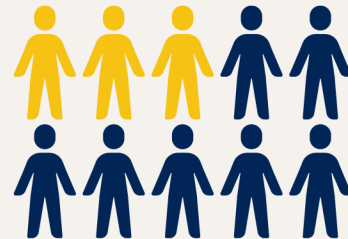
**69%**
